## **Programs**

- **RE-Edu [Professional Development Program]**

Spare Parts develops reuse education, professional development, activities and corresponding curriculum for teachers PreK-12 in all content areas.

- **RE-Mix [Creative Reuse Education Program]**

Spare Parts makes reuse activities to remember. These one-time creative programs are tailored to your event, classroom, celebration or request and audience.

- **RE-Create [Exhibitions/Long-Term Projects]**

Through partnerships, Spare Parts educates the public about reuse through art--culminating in community exhibitions/projects.

## **Spare Parts collaborates with many organizations and agencies including:**

Bexar County, Carver Community Cultural Center, City of San Antonio, City of Leon Valley, Harlandale Independent School District, Ruby, City, San Antonio Independent School District, San Antonio Public Library (SAPL) and SAPL Foundation.

In 2018, Spare Parts' Mini Art Museum interacted with more than 2,000 children at 31 schools across San Antonio.
