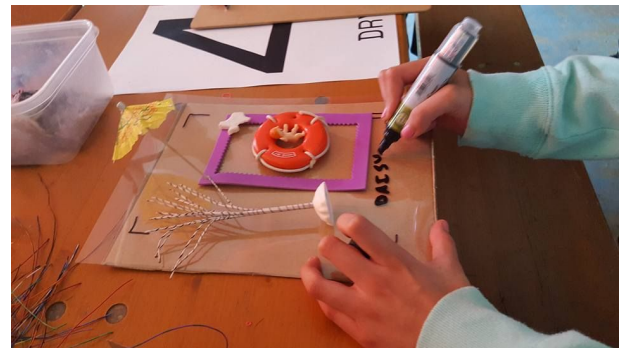
MISSION: To advance reuse education through the arts.
